## **The First Annual Brennan's Bogey Buster Scramble**

Both live and silent auctions were well received by event guests who rang up over \$20,000 in purchases. In addition to the auctions, a special donation was made by the Fremont Education Foundation District 79 in the amount of \$4,000 from raffle proceeds in Brennan's name collected at their golf outing earlier this year. Event sponsors made significant contributions as well by generously sponsoring lunch (Anthony Markeiwicz, DDS), the beverage cart which served open bar on the course (ING Financial Services), and event coordination services from David and Teresa Hassan (Events.org) who provided online registration, credit card processing, and overall event tracking and coordination software. Proceeds raised by the foundation are used to fund literacy programs and provide opportunities to kids who need extracurricular help developing their reading and writing skills. The foundation is also focused on school zone safety projects and is currently working to make flashing speed limit signs mandatory in all school zones.
